

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS – July 11, 2006

- The Church Council began the meeting (following devotions) with a facility tour to learn about Salem's campus. We focused on the Education Building, including the Fellowship Hall and various storage rooms, light switches, and shut-off valves.
- David Meyers was recommended by the Nominating Committee to be the new Steward of Evangelism. This recommendation was unanimously approved by the Church Council. Welcome David!
- Rally Day will be September 17; we will have a single worship service at 9:30 am followed by a meal and fellowship.
- As a token of their appreciation for the use of our facilities, the Disney Choir presented a donation of \$1,500 to Salem Lutheran Church. Church Council voted to allocate this money to Facilities for the purchase and installation of new, reinforced glass doors, which will provide visibility and more natural light in the Youth Center which is located in the Fellowship Hall.
- The School was authorized to install a parking lot shade structure/awning which will provide all-weather protection for the children as they enter and exit the school.
- It was announced at the Council Meeting that we have currently raised a cool \$25,000 towards the cost of the new air conditioning system in the Fellowship Hall. We will begin installation as soon as satisfactory bids are received.
