WE CELEBRATE AN EPIPHANY HYMN FESTIVAL AT A SPECIAL CONCERT ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 28TH

The concert will feature Dr. David Dahl at the organ. He is a highly-renowned, very popular recitalist and Hymn Festival leader who has been a frequent guest of the Association of Lutheran Church Musicians as well as the American Guild of Organists. Dr. Dahl is Professor of Music and University Organist Emeritus at Pacific Lutheran University where he taught for 30 years. His courses there included Hymnody and the History of Worship and many other studies of church music. As a composer, he has published organ music through Augsburg Fortress including; *Hymn Interpretations for Organ*, *An English Suite for Organ*, *An Italian Suite for Organ*, and a new *Scandinavian Suite for Organ* due for publication this year.
