

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS – February 13, 2007

- At their meeting in February, the Church Council welcomed Pam Perry as the new Steward of Member Care. Pam replaces Catherine Balck who resigned at the end of January.
- The Congregational Meeting was held on February 4, 2007 and there were about 50-60 members in attendance. The congregation gave approval to permit the Call Committee, if they choose, to select a team/couple as opposed to just a Senior Pastor.
- Council voted to accept the Statement of Vision for Salem Lutheran Church as presented by the Vision Committee (Re-imagine our resources and utilize our strengths to show the love of Jesus to our community). This is a guideline and will be presented to both the Congregation and the Call Committee.
- Council approved a recommendation to upgrade the Revelations software database which we currently use to keep track of membership information. It is hoped that this single data system would assist us in managing the flow of information within the Salem community. A Task Force consisting of Brant Reed, Steve Seekins and Barbara Denton will review this database and make some initial recommendations to Council as to how we could leverage the capabilities of the tool to improve our data capabilities. The task force would be under the umbrella of the Stewardship Committee (T.J. Denton).
- Council voted to have Tim Coffman and Tracy Germond continue as members of the Endowment Committee for a second 3-year term. Our thanks to Tim and Tracy!
